Commissioner Hajenga moved to approve the May 20, 2026 Agenda, second, motion passed.

Commissioner McDonald moved to approve the May 13, 2026 Minutes, second, motion passed.

Commissioners and Clerk Kelly meet with MACO Ins. Hope Baker and Lewistown, Ins. Scot Solberg to review bullet points of the benefits of pooling, 2026-27 Premiums, deductibles, renewal summary, JB County History claims & loss review. Proposed cost has a slight increase; however, the number of employees on the proposal was not correct. (39 and should be 35), employee count drives the cost of liability insurance. Scot will also send the property, equipment and vehicles lists to be reviewed one final time before renew deadline of June 15.

Central MT Medical Center Rick Poss, COO and JB County Ambulance Coordinator Suzanne Aune meet with the commissioners to discuss CMMC proposal for the hospital to take over JB County Ambulances Services. The hospital would like to be eligible to apply for Critical Care funds. One requirement is to be the only medical services with a 35-mile radiance and with JB County offering ambulances services in Hobson they do not qualify. Mr. Poss prepared and distributed cost estimates and proposals for the commissioners to review. Ambulance Coordinator Suzanne Aune will distribute the handouts to the volunteers; prior discussions with the volunteer's message received was a negative response to them becoming employees of CMMC.

Airport Manager Tyler Youderian meet with the commissioners to discuss the 5-year Capital Improvements plans for the airport. Tyler felt that T-hangers and fuel were the main priorities.
